## Child Care:

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday Evening for Support Group (*one evening a week*)

## Receptionist/Clerical:

Weekdays 9-5. Mornings or afternoons.

## Transportation Volunteers:

Great for volunteers who only have 1-2 hours per month to give.

## Housekeeping/Yardwork

Great for Drop-In Volunteers or regulars. Advocacy Center and crisis shelter.

## Court Accompaniment

Assist clients with filling out restraining orders and accompany them to court.

## Economic Justice

Work to empower women by assisting with financial literacy, budgeting, credit repair, etc.

## Shelter Work

Read to kids; help with homework. Assist moms with paperwork. Provide information and referral.
